 - 2. Carry one another's burdens.
 - 3. Burdens are defined as
 - a. Temptations of sin
 - b. Physical illness
 - c. Mental disorders
 - d. Financial issues
 - e. Unemployment
 - f. Family crises
 - g. And many others
 - 4. Guard against arrogance.
 - 5. We are to carry our own load.
 - 6. Fulfilment of the Law of Christ vs the Mosaic Law
 - 7. A warning against arrogance.

 - 1. We are to seize every opportunity to serve
 - 2. Work for the good of all including the family of faith.
